FEASTING BARN | DRIVING RANGE | MINI-GOLF

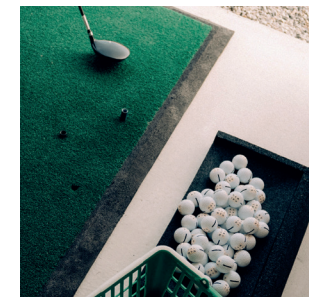
There's a new lifestyle destination in town, and the good news is that everyone is welcome.

Halwyn at Crantock is a 15 bay driving range with a difference. Visitors can practice their swing using Trackman technology – a first for Cornwall – while ordering drinks and the freshest, flame-grilled fare to their bay. But the venue is so much more than 'just' a golfers' hang. There's also a specially designed, beautifully landscaped 12-hole mini-golf course, and to round off the experience, a fire-led feasting barn, for everything from casual lunches to slap-up suppers. Or simply soak up the atmosphere on the outdoor bar terrace. It's the kind of place that the whole family can enjoy.

The vision of Will Eustice, a chartered surveyor and fourth-generation custodian of Trevowah Farm, Halwyn brings fresh purpose to land first purchased by his great-grandfather.

"Captain Jack" bought the farm back in 1944 and it has been farmed by five generations of Eustices ever since," Will explains.

Having studied real estate management and then qualified as a chartered surveyor, Will was working in property development while looking for a way to build and create something unique. He came up with the idea of Halwyn as "a beautiful space" that would be authentic to both the family story and Crantock village. The design inspiration for the whole site, including the interiors and mini golf, all originated from Will, with



a consultant team brought on board to get the ideas on paper. Construction work started on site in August 2024 and Halwyn opened for business in June.

"It's been a whirlwind," he confesses.

The team in the kitchen are as much a part of the venture as Will. Led by chef Matthew Haggath, whose background includes the Savoy Grill and Idle Rocks, they serve up dishes rooted in flame, flavour, and fresh local produce. The food ethos is all about provenance.

"The award winning Trevowah Herd prime beef that you'll find on the menu here is bred on the land by Cousin Tim. You can see the farm from the restaurant, it couldn't be any more locally-sourced," Will says. There are plans for a breakfast menu to be introduced. Then roasts and feast nights with the log burner in the autumn and winter.

Community is crucial to the venture and Will is keen to see lots of community-focused events... "as well as feast nights, weddings, private functions, corporate team building..."

"There really is something for everyone,"

Will continues. "It was about creating a social space for the community to enjoy and golf helps to facilitate that. Players of all levels can up their golf game thanks to the Trackman technology, while groups of friends can just enjoy the driving range with beers and food while the music plays in the background. Families love the mini golf, and it's open to anyone to pop in for coffee or lunch and dinner, or sundowners in the beer garden. All the parents who have visited so far, love that they can share a golf bay with friends whilst having drinks and nibbles and watching their kids hit balls."

The driving range and mini golf are open daily from 8am-9pm. Food is served Wednesday to Sunday, lunch from 12pm-3pm and dinner 5pm-9pm. Breakfast dining is due to launch soon. Bookings are available online. Golf sessions (sold in 30 min increments) include unlimited balls and accommodate up to four players per bay. Prices start at £7 per person for 30 minutes. Mini-golf is £10 per adult, £7 per child (15 and under). Private tuition with professional instructors can be arranged in one of two private booths.
