



Across Cornwall, there's a noticeable shift in how people are choosing to furnish their homes and wardrobes. Rather than buying new, more people are turning towards well-made pieces with character, longevity and a sense of story.

This summer, that shift takes physical form with the launch of Re-Loved Cornwall, a new market bringing together mid-century furniture, vintage interiors and pre-loved clothing under one roof.

Taking place at the Royal Cornwall Showground on Saturday 25 July 2026, the event is designed as a destination for those who appreciate good design and well-made objects, whether that's a restored sideboard, a statement chair, or a piece of clothing with real individuality.

Re-Loved Cornwall has grown out of Casta Blue, the mid-century furniture and interiors shop based in St Columb Major. Known for restoring British and Scandinavian pieces, the business has built a following around the idea that good design should last. The event extends that thinking beyond furniture, bringing together a wider mix of traders who share a similar approach to quality and sustainable living.



Visitors can expect a carefully selected mix of sellers from across Cornwall and the South West, offering everything from mid-century furniture and lighting to vintage homeware and pre-loved fashion. The aim is not to recreate a traditional antiques fair, but to offer something more focused, a space where different strands of vintage and re-used design sit comfortably alongside one another.

Clothing is a key part of the line-up, reflecting a growing interest in buying pre-loved rather than new. From everyday

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wear to standout pieces, it sits naturally alongside interiors, forming part of a broader shift towards more considered consumption.



The emphasis throughout is on re-use rather than replacement. These are pieces that have already stood the test of time, and continue to hold value both functionally and aesthetically.

Alongside the traders, a small selection of street food vendors and a relaxed indoor setting will give the day a social, informal feel, somewhere to browse, spend time, and discover something unexpected.
